FREE SPEECH AND FINE MOTOR SCREENINGS

SPEECH SCREENINGS

The Fluharty Preschool Speech and Language Screening Test is administered by a licensed Speech Pathologist to rapidly identify preschool children who may benefit from a complete speech and language evaluation.

FINE MOTOR SCREENINGS

A licensed occupational therapist administers a screening tool for fine motor, visual motor and sensory processing skills. Findings are compared with expected age levels.

What is a good reason to schedule a screening?

- If you or your child's teacher have concerns, but you are not ready for a full evaluation or you are not sure that one is necessary.
- You want a professional opinion regarding your child's development.

What is the difference between a screening and an evaluation?

- A screening is brief 20minute meeting that allows the professional to get some basic information to determine if a more in-depth evaluation is needed.
- An evaluation is in-depth and can result in a diagnosis and a plan of treatment. It requires an intake process and comprehensive testing.
